**"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road when you lie down, and when you get up."**

In other words, you are to teach your children God's principles daily. You cannot compete with a secular society by only trying to teach your children God's principles at church on Sunday, once a week. You must be very intentional in placing your children under godly instruction throughout each day of their lives and be consistent with their teaching.

Our purpose as a school can be summed up in Psalm 78:4-7, where King David urges us not to hide God's teachings from the next generation, but to tell the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord to our children "so the next generation would know them, even the children yet to be born, and they in turn would tell their children. 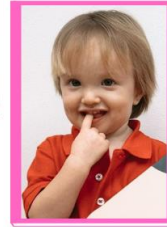

In addition to these Bible stories, we will go through Unit 16: I See Changes in the Weather and Unit 13: I can express my feelings. The letters we will be focusing on are M, N, and O, as well as the colors pink, red, and purple. We will also be focusing on the numbers 11 and 12, and the shapes heart and star.

As we continue our journey together, we encourage you to reinforce the topics covered in class with your child at home. Simple activities, discussions, and reading together can greatly enhance their learning experience and make these lessons even more meaningful. During this month, the theme will be: "In the City, In the Country." In Reading, the children will continue with phonemes and will begin matching words with the same beginning sounds. They will also be learning new sight words and continuing to read new stories in class.

In Writing, the children will focus on the letters Cc, Qq, Vv, and the sounds they make. We will teach them new words related to the theme to expand their vocabulary.

In Expression of the Arts, the children will work on a variety of skills related to their needs and the theme. We will also focus on art using different colors, textures, and shapes. The children will create original works with form and meaning.

In Math, we will work on problem solving, money, weight, and capacity.

Dear Parents,

What a wonderful way to end our month with the 100 Days of School celebration! The students had a fantastic time designing their shirts for the event and engaging in fun, hands-on activities. They also thoroughly enjoyed the Carnival and had a memorable classroom experience. In January, we also celebrated our Honor Awards Ceremony. During Language Arts, the students learned about topic sentences, supporting details, and ending sentences, as well as adverbs and adjectives.
